Bonnington Rose Bowl (best picture in Exhibition). **Lyn Randall Award** (best pastel)
Josie Chapman Award (best Watercolour). **The Most Popular Picture** (voted by the public).
The Vandoeuvre Award (Abstract) **Highly Commended Certificates** (x6).

Members are entitled to exhibit:

Up to **6** paintings and up to **5** mounted (but unframed) in the browsers.

Costs:

There is a hanging fee of **£3.00** per picture and **£1.00** per unframed painting/print in the browsers). A commission is payable to Arnold Art Society for each type of sale, at 15%.

Your Entries:

- Submissions should preferably have been completed recently.
- Member's pictures may be re-exhibited, as long as a period of more than 12 months has elapsed.
- No exhibition award winning picture may be re-entered.
- Internal competition winners may submit their winning art work.

Arnold Art Society - Terms & Conditions

Picture Framing:

- Pictures must be framed to a good standard, having 'D' rings and picture cord or wire attached approximately one third of the way down each side of the frame. Each painting must be labelled on the back with the Artist's name, address, email address and telephone number. Title, medium and price. Unframed canvasses will need well finished edges. (see separate instruction regarding how to prepare your pictures for the exhibition).

- **There is a limit on SIZE of pictures entered.**

Each picture, on average should not exceed 70cm (when measured DIAGONALLY) and all your entries should not exceed a total of 420cm. If your pictures are TOO LARGE, then you will need to REDUCE the number entered, so the maximum limit of 420cm is NOT EXCEEDED!

Pictures for the Browsers:

- Pictures for the Browser section, should be Unframed, but with mounts. They must be labelled clearly on the back, with Artist's name, address, email address and telephone number. Title, medium and price. **Must state if Original or Print.** Framing size should be indicated. Covered in clear plastic, as protection.

Hanging the Pictures:

- The Exhibition Hanging Team determines the hanging position of exhibits. Although every care will be taken with exhibits, the Society cannot accept any responsibility for Loss or damage.

- The Exhibition Team will hang all submissions where physically possible. However, members will realise that space is limited. The Exhibition Team decision is final. At the end of the Exhibition Please help dismantle exhibition, when you collect your unsold paintings on **Sunday 26th October** (from 5.00pm.)

Digital Art:

Digital Art must be wholly created using a drawing pad/computer and should be printed and framed in the same manner as other entries. It should be a limited edition and signed. (The number of the edition should be displayed i.e. 1/20 that is the first print in a series which is limited to twenty)

Payments for items sold:

Payments for pictures, browsers sold (less AAS commission) will be made by the Treasurer as soon as possible after the exhibition.
